NOTICE

The FRS board room was designed and constructed in 1980. At that time there was no requirement for FRS to know the maximum load capacity of the board room, nor was there a reason to ask for that determination to be made. No one ever asked. However, during the recent Covid-19 pandemic, the Governor issued proclamations limiting the number of persons allowed in any room to 25%, then 50%, and then 75% of the maximum load capacity. For that reason, FRS was required to ask the state fire marshal for a determination of the maximum room capacity for purposes of adhering so the capacity limitations.

The capacity limitation of the FRS conference room is a maximum of 15 persons (copy attached), as determined by the Louisiana State Fire Marshal. Unfortunately, that capacity load is attained by the board members and staff, thereby leaving insufficient square footage to accommodate inperson public attendance.

For the above reasons, the board meeting scheduled for July 8, 2021, has been moved to the DoubleTree Hotel in Baton Rouge (address shown above). The meeting is also available by audio/video teleconferencing. Any person (including the public) can choose to attend by teleconference and submit comments regarding matters on the agenda.
