What do we need from you?

- Complete the **Registry Survey** shared by your Primary Fire Department Chief.
- This survey will collect your working experience in the fire service and obtain your information for secure linkage with the LTR database.
- Your personal information will be protected and used by LTR only.
- Your timely completion of the survey will help improve the overall health of firefighters, and we greatly appreciate your effort.
